

CSA Z96-09 CLASSIFICATION CHART:

Class	Visibility	Body Coverage	Examples of Jobs
1	Good	Basic harness or over shoulders & encircling waist of hi-visibility material	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Directing vehicle operators to parking/ service locations• Warehouse operations• Right of way or sidewalk maintenance
2	Better	Full coverage of upper torso. Stripes of retro-reflective or combined performance materials.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Where vehicles or equipment moving from 40-80 km/hr• Inclement weather or low light• Have complex background• Working in or near flowing traffic
3	Best	Same as 2 with addition of arm & leg bands. Garment made of hi-visibility material and striped made of retro-reflective or combined performance materials.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Where vehicles or equipment exceed 80 km/hr• In icy, snowy weather or low light or night time• High volume traffic and unmonitored equipment movement• Near vehicles with multi-task loads with diverted operator attention
